This small movement has grown on the musical "playgrounds" of the Bach successors.

The neo-baroque style is clearly derived from the model of the famous Air from the D-major orchestra suite.

The transposition to G-major and two passages shifted by 1 octave make this

Miniature even more interesting. Very suitable as an interlude. The bass voice should be interpreted with a discreet 16' and non legato.
