"Joy to the World" ist ein beliebtes Weihnachtslied mit Worten von Isaac Watts. Im späten 20. Jahrhundert war "Joy to the World" die meistveröffentlichte Weihnachtshymne in Nordamerika.

Die Worte des Liedes stammen vom englischen Schriftsteller Isaac Watts und basieren auf Psalm 98, 96:11-12 und Genesis 3:17-18. Das Lied wurde erstmals 1719 in Watts' Sammlung The Psalms of David: Imitiert in der Sprache des Neuen Testaments und angewandt auf den christlichen Staat und Gottesdienst veröffentlicht. Die Paraphrase ist Watts' christologische Interpretation.
