Menuett

Measures 1-5 of the Minuet. The music is in 3/4 time and G major. The first staff (treble clef) starts with a melody in measure 1, followed by a half rest in measure 2, and continues with eighth and sixteenth notes. Dynamic markings of *p* and *mf* are present in measures 27 and 29, respectively. The piece concludes with a double bar line and repeat dots in measure 31.
