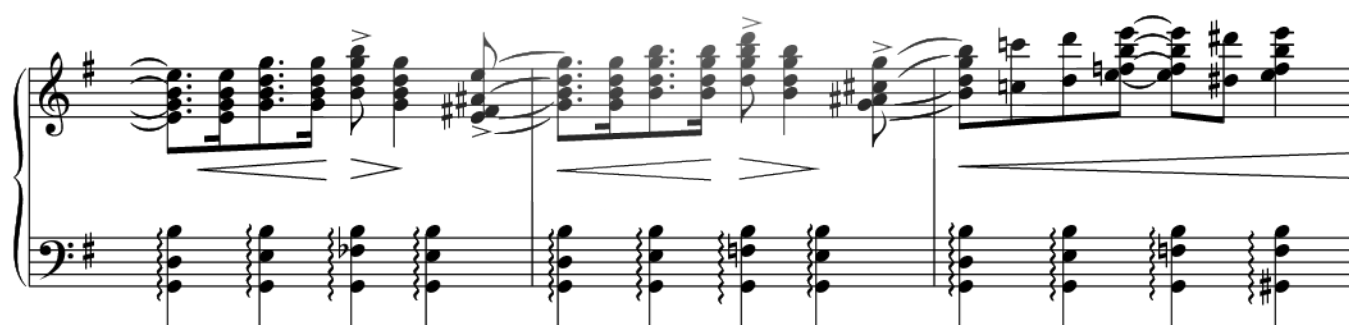
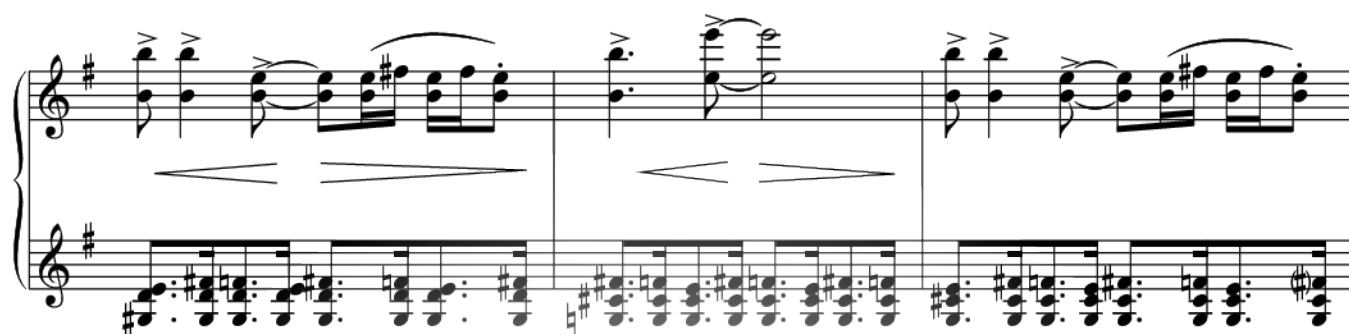


Sweet And Low-Down
