This technically undemanding, almost " crazy " small organ piece is a typical representative of Italian style from the 2nd half of the 18th century and very suitable to conclude the service as a so-called kicker at cheerful parish festivals. In order to give the composition even more "bite", small changes in the musical text are already hinted at, but can, which is stylistically completely in order only increase the joy of the listeners. The original, by the way, does not provide for pedal use which however, was usual if the instrument had a pedal in order to underline the sound effect in a few but important places.
