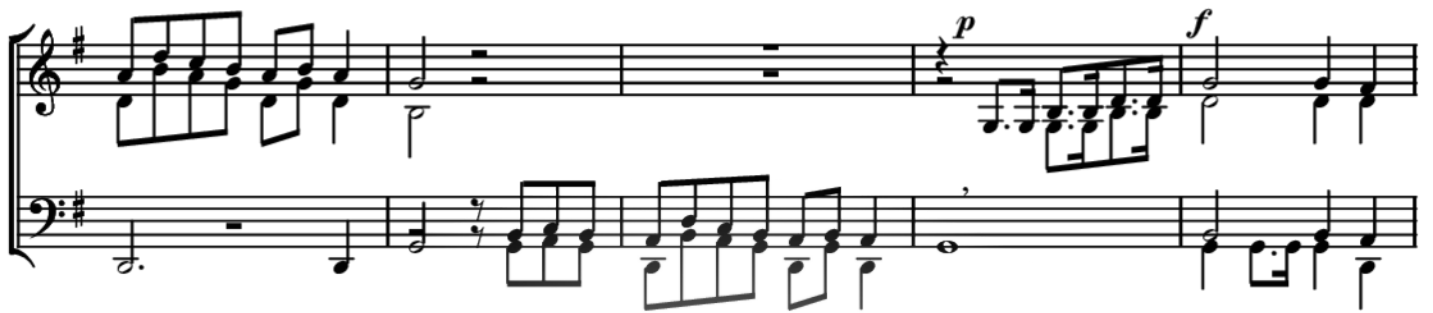


VOLUNTARY
