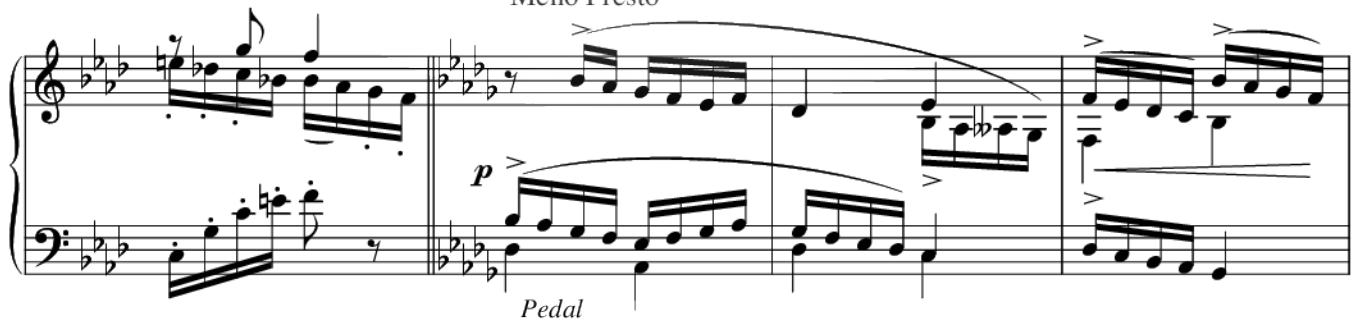

ff *f staccato*
